

## NGS & PGX TESTING SPECIMEN COLLECTION & SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS

The ORAcollect.Dx OCD-100 specimen collection kit is intended and designed for the collection and stabilization of DNA from human oral samples. Each "set" contains one collection kit.

Warnings and Precautions: Choking hazard. Caution should be used when inserting swab/ sponge into mouth, especially for younger and/or disabled patients.

Wash with water if liquid inside collection kit comes into contact with eyes and/or skin. Do NOT ingest.

## SPECIMEN COLLECTION & PREPARATION

- Open package and remove collector device without touching the sponge/swab tip. Place sponge as far back in the mouth as is comfortable and rub along the lower gums in a back-and forth motion.
   Gently rub the gums ten times, avoiding the teeth, if possible.
- 2. Repeat the rubbing motion on the opposite side of the mouth, along the lower gums, for an additional ten times.
- 3. Hold the tube upright to prevent the liquid inside the tube from spilling. Unscrew the blue cap from the collection tube without touching the sponge.
- 4. Turn <u>only the cap</u> upside down and insert the sponge into the tube. Screw the cap into place tightly to avoid leakage.
- 5. Invert the capped tube and shake vigorously ten times.
- 6. Write with indelible ink the patient's name, DOB, date/time of specimen collection, and collector's initials.
- 7. Place the tube in a biohazard bag and seal the bag tightly.
- 8. Place the patient's completed test requisition form and any additional documents in the external document pocket of the biohazard bag.
- The specimen is ready for shipping.
   NGS & PGX specimens can be shipped at ambient/room temperature.
   Between collection and shipping, specimens should be kept refrigerated.
